1) How do you feel after using the UbiDuo to communicate freely with hearing people in your office?

The UbiDuo makes me feel more involved and relaxed knowing I didn't have to try to hard to understand what was being said by more then one person

2) What are your thoughts and emotions as you are able to hold your own conversations on the UbiDuo?

Since I am not as fluent in sign language as I would like to be, the main way I communicate is by lip reading. With the UbiDuo, I feel happy knowing I was an active part in the conversation.

3) What situations have you used the UbiDuo in such as meetings or social functions?

Every week, our staff holds a meeting. The UbiDuo comes in very handy during these meetings. It is almost impossible for me to catch everything just by lip reading everyone.

UbiDuo Tip – Inserting Emoticons

The UbiDuos are programmed with 11 emoticons that you can use during your chat sessions. To access the emoticon list, press F1. Press Esc to return to the chat session, and then press the
